#### • Creating Your User Page

- In the upper right of the page, below the search box, there are a number of options. One of them will be your **username** (your first and last name), there will also be a little user icon next to it.
- Click on your name to create your user page.
- You will see a couple of tabs at the top of the page (above the word Climate). One of them will be **edit**, click this tab to begin adding content into your page



- Here you can enter information about you including:
  - Name
  - Research Interests
  - Institution Affiliation
  - Interest in the Climate Change: Science, Society, and Solutions course
  - Links to a Facebook page if you have one.
  - Upload an image if you would like (see Add Image below in General Wiki Help).

- Click the **Browse** button and find the image you want on your page.
- Once you have selected your file, click the **Upload file** button. Your image is now ready to use on a page. Make sure you copy the name of the image from the page; you cannot find it without the name.
- Add image to page.
- To add the image to an article, go to the article and click **edit** at the top of the page. Once in the editing window, click on the button with the landscape.



This will add a line to the article, [[Image:Example.jpg]]. Within the brackets, change the highlighted portion to the name of your uploaded image. Save your work and there should now be an image on your page.

- Adding Links
  - Internal links To add internal links (links to other articles or categories on the Wiki) use the Ab button. Type the name of the link inside the brackets. •  $B \swarrow Ab \textcircled{Ab} \textcircled{A$

### • <u>Helpful resources and tools</u>

- Wikipedia is a great example of a Wiki and runs on the same software that the ODC does.
- The Watch tool allows you to track changes to a particular pages. To Watch a page simply go to the page and click watch. To remove the page from your Watch List, simply click Unwatch (the same location as the Watch link.)
